SOCIAL WORK PROGRESS NOTE

On Sunday, March 24th, 1991, [redacted] visited with his sister, [redacted] and brother, [redacted] at [redacted] home in [redacted]. He was accompanied by [redacted] (Residential Counsellor) and [redacted] (Social Work).

The visit was originally planned with [redacted] mother, however on arrival [redacted] informed us her mother had had an asthmatic attack and was unable to visit with [redacted].

This was the first family visit for [redacted] in a number of years (last contact from family was March 1989) and [redacted] and [redacted] were excited about seeing [redacted]. [redacted] had purchased cookies and prepared tea for the occasion.

[redacted] continues to reside at [redacted]. He appeared somewhat anxious and spent much of the time we were there intently listening to his radio.

[redacted] indicated that Mrs. [redacted] has a number of Christmas presents for [redacted] and was wondering if he could visit sometime without staff. It was indicated that we might consider that in the future but for now [redacted] required staff to accompany him. He can become agitated when in the community. This can lead to situations where he clings tightly to others with him and inadvertently he may injure them.

We did suggest that family members could visit with [redacted] at H.R.C. Another visit to [redacted] may be planned closer to next Christmas.

[redacted] travelled well and appeared to enjoy the visit.
