[REDACTED] was born on September 8th, 1961 and was admitted to Huronia Regional Centre on December 3rd, 1973.

The Clinical Abstract gives a thorough family and personal history prior to [REDACTED]'s admission to Huronia Regional Centre. At the time of admission, he was a ward of the Children's Aid Society. At that time it was felt that he could not be managed in a non-institutional setting. His behaviour was quite aggressive. After admission his medical history reveals fractured left hip treated with ORIF in 1978. The same year, his first epileptic seizure occurred. The seizures were considered generalized tonic-clonic. The EEG in 1989 shows not focal features, no sharp waves or spikes. He was treated with Dilantin and Phenobarb and was taking infrequent seizures. In 1996 he took 9 seizures; in 1997, so far, 3 seizures. Last seizure was recorded on August 11th, 1997. Dilantin use caused gingivitis that required gingivectomy in 1996. I initiated replacement of Dilantin with Valproate. He is presently on 500 mg. three times a day. I also started to taper off Phenobarbital and suggested that Dilantin be also tapered off after Phenobarb is discontinued. Most recent blood levels (1997 October 14) - Phenobarb: 68 (65-170); Dilantin: 51 (Normal = 40-80); Valproate: 266 (Normal = 350-700). [REDACTED] fractured his left metatarsal bone in 1983 and was treated for pneumonia of the right lung later that same year. In 1992 he was seen by a psychiatrist for behaviour problems. The report is enclosed. In April 1997, I was able to discontinue early morning dose of Nozinan and as of today I have seen no increase in undesirable behaviours. In May 1996 during an epileptic seizure he fell and fractured nasal bones.
