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Mother well during pregnancy. Spontaneous labor at 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  months.

First tooth at 8 months. Sat up at ten months, walked at  
4 yrs. Requires complete nursing care.

June 1953 - acute intussusception requiring right colectomy.  
Feight, weight and head measurements all less than average.

Restless, unco-operative, walks by himself. Does not talk.

No evidence of seizures.
