SOCIAL WORK PROGRESS NOTE

RE: [redacted] visiting his family.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

[redacted] sister, [redacted] had requested that he take the Easter bus in March 1989 and she would meet the bus on the highway. [redacted] behaviour can be affected by being in a new environment and with people he does not know well. It was felt therefore, that it would be in the best interests of both [redacted] and his family if he was accompanied by H.R.C. staff to his home for visits to see how he reacted.

Arrangements were made twice to take [redacted] for a visit but the visits were cancelled at the request of the family. The arrangements required several telephone calls each time because [redacted] mother had to confer with [redacted] about her time off. [redacted] appears to be the member of the family who assumes responsibility when her sister [redacted] and brother [redacted] come for visits from their group homes.

After the second visit was cancelled no further attempt was made to set-up a time for another visit. [redacted] family has not been in touch since I last spoke to [redacted] in June 1989.

I had a conversation with [redacted] Executive Director of [redacted] where [redacted] lives. He recommended that if [redacted] was going to visit sometime overnight with his family that [redacted] not be at home overnight. He felt having both brothers there at the same time could be more than [redacted] could cope with.

COMMENTS:

During this past year [redacted] behaviour has become more unpredictable especially when there are new staff. He seems better behaved when he is with staff he knows well.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

At [redacted] annual review on December 13, 1989 the team decided a caution should be put on [redacted] file that he should be accompanied by staff familiar to him if he goes off the H.R.C. grounds.
