SOCIAL ASSESSMENT

[REDACTED] was admitted to the Ontario Hospital, Orillia on Monday, 3rd. December from the Sunbeam Home, Kitchener. He was accompanied by Mr. [REDACTED] the owner of the Sunbeam Home and Mrs. [REDACTED] formerly of the Ontario Hospital, who is now a supervising nurse at Sunbeam.

CIRCUMSTANCES LEADING TO ADMISSION:

[REDACTED] has been in the Sunbeam Home since August 1965. He has been a ward of the Children's Aid Society since he was removed from his mother's care in 1965. [REDACTED] had become too much of a problem for his mother to cope with. There is no family contact now. David has now outgrown the facilities of Sunbeam Home, which is geared to the care of younger children.

PERSONAL ASSESSMENT:**Incorrect name**

David is a severely retarded boy. The staff of Sunbeam describe him as moderately active, but not a behaviour problem. They think his level of activity has declined over the years, and he now spends quite a lot of time sitting on his own or looking out of the window. He does not appear to be interested in other children nor will he play with toys on his own initiative. He will play with toys and recreation equipment such as a tricycle for short periods under supervision.

**Incorrect name**

David is said to be affectionate but will punch or hurt the person he is hugging. He is not aggressive, and will push away children who are aggressive to him without much retaliation.

He has no speech but understands simple commands. He feeds himself and is partially toilet-trained to routine. He needs some help dressing.

SUMMARY:**Incorrect name**

David is a Children's Aid Society ward who will need permanent residential care. He has some withdrawn behaviour so he should be involved in an activity programme
