On October 21, [redacted] and her husband, [redacted] came to Huronia Regional Centre with a copy of [redacted] clinical record.

They were on their way to Resident Records to ask that the record be changed because [redacted] resented being described as an imbecile and an idiot and was upset by other contents of the report. I explained to [redacted] that it is not possible to change an existing record, but that she could be reassessed, as the language used in report writing in the sixty's is no longer acceptable or in use professionally.

I had a long talk with Mr. & Mrs. [redacted] and they told me the story of [redacted] previous marriage and the loss of her children to the Childrens' Aid Society. I contacted [redacted] Centre who told me that [redacted] centre would be most willing to provide free of charge an up-to-date psychological assessment for [redacted]
