SOCIAL WORK SUMMARY

Date of Birth : [redacted] 1961

Date of Admission: Dec. 3, 1973.

[redacted] is an 18 year old young man. He was admitted to the Metro C.A.S. care directly from home on August 12, 1965. Crown Wardship for [redacted] was granted on Sept. 8, 1965. Since then [redacted] was placed at Sunbream until he was admitted to H.R.C.

[redacted] has been classified as profoundly retarded. He has no speech but understands simple commands. He makes little eye contact and exhibits a short attention span. [redacted] is toilet-trained during the day time but wets at night. He can dress himself but needs help on shoelaces and buttons.

[redacted] has been attending Sensory program of the Occupational Therapy Department regularly. He needs a great deal of reinforcement to complete a task. [redacted] seems to enjoy the program but needs constant prompting.

[redacted] ward programs are: personal hygiene, dressing skills, toileting, dental hygiene and socialization, etc.

[redacted] has been recommended for the total communication program at H.R.C. in order to upgrade his speech. He would be transferred to that area when it materializes.

It was reported that [redacted] sister, an ex-resident of H.R.C. who lives at a group home in Barrie comes to see him but [redacted] shows no interest in her.

The Crown Wardship was terminated on his 18th birthday.
