has been attending Sensory program of the Occupational Therapy Department regularly. He needs a great deal of reinforcement to complete a task. seems to enjoy the program but needs constant prompting.

ward programs are: personal hygiene, dressing skills, toileting, dental hygiene and socialization,

has been recommended for the total communication program at H.R.C. in order to upgrade his speech. He would be transferred to that area when it materializes.

It was reported that sister, an ex-resident of H.R.C. who lives at a group home in Barrie comes to see him but shows no interest in her.

The Crown Wardship was terminated on his 18th birthday.
