On Sunday June 29th I received a call from the R.C. 4 on duty at Huronia Regional Centre. She told me that two people who claimed they were relatives of I of our ex-residents, had 'phoned enquiring as to whereabouts. They said they wished to pick up her to a wedding and had lost her address. I informed the R.C. 4 that. was living in a community group home in Orillia and gave her the address. The R.C. 4 said she would screan the applicants if they arrived at Huronia Regional Centre to make sure whether they seemed to be reliable people who aught to have \_\_\_\_\_address.
