TEST FINDINGS AND COMMENTS:

This is a boy of fair size for his years and with brown hair worn in a brushcut. He is a fairly nice looking lad but rarely smiles. He sat in a chair rocking from side to side and it was not possible to focus his attention. He kept moving his head all around. He does not like to be restrained and would not hold still for the testing. He showed no interest whatever in the test materials presented to him. Everything shown to him he grabs, smells and throws away.

There is no language development at all. Eye-hand co-ordination is limited.

teeping habits are good and is tied in the crib. He has a good appetite and feeds himself with help. No toilet training has been possible.

does not relate to anyone, either adult or child.

Assessment: Continues to be a grossly Defective child with an I.Q. under 25.
He continues to show autistic symptoms.
