

April 23/69.

- was admitted involuntarily Feb. 25, 1969
- she was therefore certified upon admission (we can decide who may & may not take her out.)
- Involuntary status is continued <sup>if necessary</sup> by certificates of renewal signed by a doctor according to the following schedule set up in section 13 of the New Mental Health Act (1967):

- 1st. certificate of renewal - 1 month after admission. (March 1969)
- 2nd. Cert. of renewal - 3 months after admission (May 1969)
- 3rd. Cert. of renewal - 6 months after admission (Aug. 1969)
- 4th. Cert. of renewal - 12 months after admission (Feb. ~~1970~~<sup>1970</sup>)
- (Subsequent certificates every 12 months.)

Dr. [redacted] renewed the certificate once in March. He feels that this should be continued for a while - for [redacted] protection from her family.

- It seems best that [redacted] family visit her on the ward, or on the grounds, only for the time being.

- her brother, who have been "interested" in taking her out recently are:

[redacted] lives in Quilley, has apparently attended some of the dances here.

- parents are [redacted]

- [redacted] has written to someone named [redacted]

- she considers that he is her boyfriend & wants to marry him. It seems like hero worship.

- [redacted] knows some ladies who work in the laundry here who apparently (she says) want to take her out. It's likely that she has manipulated them & that they don't understand that
